



PROFESSIONAL PRACTICE FRAMEWORK (PPF) IMPLEMENTATION

‘TRAIN THE TRAINER’ NATIONAL WORKSHOPS

The PPF is the collection of national standards and codes developed to identify the scope and responsibilities of nursing and midwifery professional practice in Australia.

In July 2010 Australian health professional regulation moves to a national process for regulation. Nursing and Midwifery Regulatory Authorities will be replaced by the Nursing and Midwifery Board of Australia (NMBA), and all nurses and midwives will be required to meet the national standards endorsed by the NMBA.

The PPF Implementation workshops are designed to assist the nursing and midwifery professions in preparing for this change.

For those who would like to attend the workshops we are targeting experienced registered nurses and midwives with specific skills and a clinical focus who will ‘train the trainer’ in their workplaces.

There is no cost to participants, but registration is essential.
